Item 1: Approval of Agenda and Minutes

The Steering Group (SG) approved the proposed agenda and the minutes of the SG meeting on 21 February 2024.

Item 2: Annual Conference

The ICN Annual Conference will take place in Sauipe, Brazil, from 14 to 17 May 2024. The conference host, the Brazilian Administrative Council for Economic Defense (CADE), informed the SG members about the current status of the preparations. The ICN Secretariat presented the proposed plenary speakers, which were approved by the SG members.

Item 3: Operational Framework

The Operational Framework Working Group Co-Chairs informed the SG members about the status of the Operational Framework review and the upcoming group calls which are scheduled for 27 March and 3 April 2024. The ICN Chair opened the floor to the SG members to share their views on what aspects to prioritise. Aspects mentioned included the importance of the division of tasks within the virtual network/within the ICN, also in view of increased rotation, as well as ensuring an appropriate level of detail regarding any additional procedures defined in the Operational Framework due to the dynamic nature of the ICN.

Item 4: Workshops

The Competition Authority of Kenya reported on the successful Advocacy Workshop which took place in Nairobi from 22 to 23 February.

The Mexican COFECE provided information on the Cartel Workshop in October 2024.

The FTC provided an update on the Technologists Group Forum in Washington, DC from 25 to 26 March 2024 and shared its ideas for a joint statement by the participants, which was supported by the SG members.

<u>Item 5: Working Group Status Reports</u>

The Co-Chairs of the Agency Effectiveness Working Group reported on the status of the group's projects, focusing on the projects "Gathering and Using Information for Effective Strategic Planning" and "Monitoring and Measuring Effectiveness".

<u>Item 6: SG Members' Hot Topics Presentation</u>

DG COMP gave a presentation focusing on market definition in digital markets on the occasion of its revision of the Market Definition Notice.

Item 7: Other Business

The ICN Secretariat provided an update on ICN funding for attending the Annual Conference in Brazil.
